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## ***PROGRAM ACTIVITIES EXPLAINED***

- 1. Projects Presentation** - Each delegation will present the project developed in their own country to a group of 6 to 7 other delegations. There will be 5 to 6 rooms for simultaneous presentations. **2 times**
- 2. Third round of Presentation of selected projects**
- 3. Working session** - There will be different working groups to which the students were asked to assign for on the first day of the conference:
  1. Communication - video, poster, press release, performance, manifesto & song
  2. Change Actions - Beach cleaning campaign, painting a mural, banners for the march for the Oceans, Creating panels & Awareness raising sessions in kindergartens (on marine litter degradation, sustainable fish consumption, micro plastic in sediments and sand, etc.)
- 4. Poster Exhibition** - Each delegation will bring a poster of their project (**A1** 59,4 x 84,1cm )
- 5. Outdoor Activities and trips** -  $\frac{1}{2}$  day Visits with workshops or 10-minutes talk on site
