- 2. Third round of Presentation of selected projects
- **3.** Working session There will be different working groups to which the students were asked to assign for on the first day of the conference:
 - 1. Communication video, poster, press release, performance, manifesto & song
 - 2. Change Actions Beach cleaning campaign, painting a mural, banners for the march for the Oceans, Creating panels & Awareness raising sessions in kindergartens (on marine litter degradation, sustainable fish consumption, micro plastic in sediments and sand, etc.)
